PRAYER PROMPTS

During the prayer tour, there will be multiple opportunities to pray out loud or reflect silently. Sometimes it's hard to know what to say and how to pray in that space. We have included some prayer prompts and Scriptures to help guide you -

FOR WHEN YOU DON'T KNOW WHAT TO PRAY AND FOR DURING SILENT REFLECTION:

Imagine holding the big, complicated thing in your hand and handing it to Jesus. In handing it to him, you can say:

Come, Lord Jesus.

Fix what is broken.

This is _____ (scary, complicated, not the way it is supposed to be...).

God, we need you to change it!

FROM THESE PASSAGES TO PRAY FOR
WHAT YOU SEE AROUND THE CITY:

PSALM 36:5-9 NIV "Your love, Lord, reaches to the heavens, your faithfulness to the skies. Your righteousness is like the highest mountains, your justice like the great deep. You, Lord, preserve both people and animals. How priceless is your unfailing love, O God! People take refuge in the shadow of your wings. They feast on the abundance of your house; you give them drink from your river of delights. For with you is the fountain of life; in your light we see light."

PSALM 67:1-3 NIV "May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face shine on us— so that your ways may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations. May the peoples praise you, God; may all the peoples praise you."

ISAIAH 41:10 NIV "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

PSALM 13 ESV "How long, O LORD? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me? How long must I take counsel in my soul and have sorrow in my heart all the day? How long shall my enemy be exalted over me? Consider and answer me, O LORD my God; light up my eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death, lest my enemy say, "I have prevailed over him," lest my foes rejoice because I am shaken. But I have trusted in your steadfast love; my heart shall rejoice in your salvation. I will sing to the LORD, because he has dealt bountifully with me."

PSALM 79:9-11 ESV "Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of your name; deliver us, and atone for our sins, for your name's sake! Why should the nations say, "Where is their God?" Let the avenging of the outpoured blood of your servants be known among the nations before our eyes! Let the groans of the prisoners come before you; according to your great power, preserve those doomed to die!"

PSALM 79:8-10 MSG "Hurry up and help us; we're at the end of our rope. You're famous for helping; God, give us a break. Your reputation is on the line. Pull us out of this mess, forgive us our sins — do what you're famous for doing!

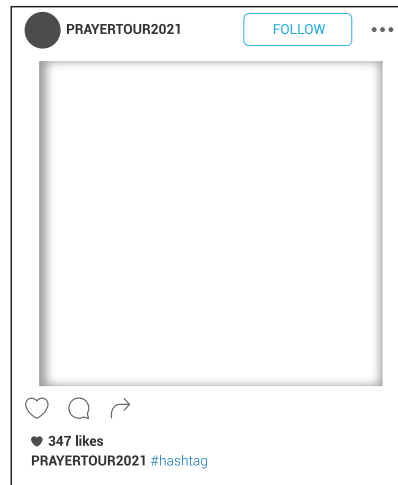
